

Invitation for Expression of Interest for Pre-qualification for construction services

(13/2012/special works)

Project: Reuse of treated wastewater for irrigation in the Northern Jordan Vally.

The Water Authority of Jordan (WAJ) through the Ministry of Water and Irrigation, special tender committee in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, invites competent contractors, joint ventures or consortiums to submit pre-qualification information for construction of the Bid Package 3: **Construction of Treated Wastewater Conveyance and Distribution Systems Including pipe works, mixing stations and pump stations. which includes the following major components:**

- Main Treated Wastewater (TWW) Pipeline from a point just upstream of the Wadi Arab Reservoir to Shounna (approx. 4.8 km)
- Main Treated Wastewater (TWW) Pipeline from Shounna to Turn Outs TO14, TO22, TO24, TO10 and TO11 along the King Abdullah Canal (approx. 14.2 km).
- Proposed mixing stations and connections to the existing pumped and gravity water irrigation systems at TO14, TO22, TO24, TO10 and TO11 with control and shut off valves and flow meters
- Inlet and outlet piping and connections to the proposed equalization storage basin near Wadi Arab Reservoir
- Concrete lining to an existing equalization/storage tank
- A Mixing station for mixing the TWW with fresh water downstream of the equalization basin
- TWW piping from Shounna to the Jordan River with a total distance of 2.2km
- Rehabilitation of pump stations at TO14, TO22, TO24, TO10, and TO11.
- Electrical and SCADA system improvements at the pumping stations at TO14, TO22, TO24, TO10, and TO11.
- SCADA enhancements on the proposed TWW pipeline for monitoring flows and pressures for control of TWW discharge to the turn outs

Applicants seeking pre-qualification for these bids are:

- a. Jordanian contractors, as an individual or as a joint venture who satisfy the pre-qualification requirements.
- b. International contractors with joint ventures or subcontracting with local contractors who satisfy the prequalification requirements.
- c. Have an average turnover more than JOD 12 million per year in the last 5 years.

For non-Jordanian applicants, the submittal of a declaration to work with a Jordanian Company (e.g. for the supply of goods or construction works) is sufficient to fulfill the requirements under b above.

A nomination of specific Jordanian company in the tender is not required.

Note: Jordanian contractors should be first grade classified by Government tenders Directorate (GTD) in water and wastewater treatment plants.
